He is best known for his children's novels, including *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory*, *Soylent Green*, and *The BFG*. He also wrote the screenplay for the 1964 film *Chitty Chitty Bang Bang*. Dahl's writing is characterized by its dark, macabre, and often satirical tone, as well as its focus on the lives of children and the adult world they inhabit.
